

The main language used in Indonesia is Indonesian (What a surprise). Although, they also speak about 700 more languages. Hello in Indonesian is Halo.


## Flag

The Indonesia flag is a rectangular flag which consists of a red stripe above and a white stripe below. Indonesia did not always have this flag but, the other flags weren't really Indonesia's flag but a flag from another country that waged war with Indonesia. Apart from the flag that is used in the navy which is basically the normal flag but the pattern continues downward.

### Population

Indonesia's population is about 275,254,000. The pie chart on the left shows the percentages of different ethnic groups in Indonesia from 2010. (There are a total of 21 ethnic groups )Note: The chart does not include all of the names of every ethnic group.

The foreign settlers of Indonesia include: Chinese, Arabs, Indian, Indos, Mardjikers and Japanese people.



### Currency

Indonesia's currency is called Indonesian rupiah. It has 8 different notes and 5 different coins. The name "Rupiah" originates from the Sanskrit word rupyakam. Many other countries such as India use names same or similar.




### Fun facts
