
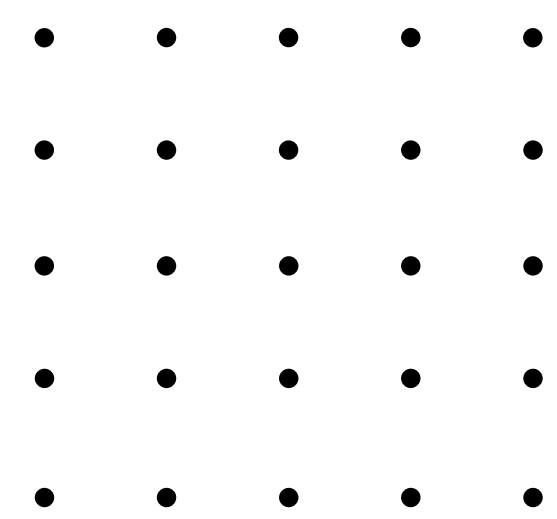

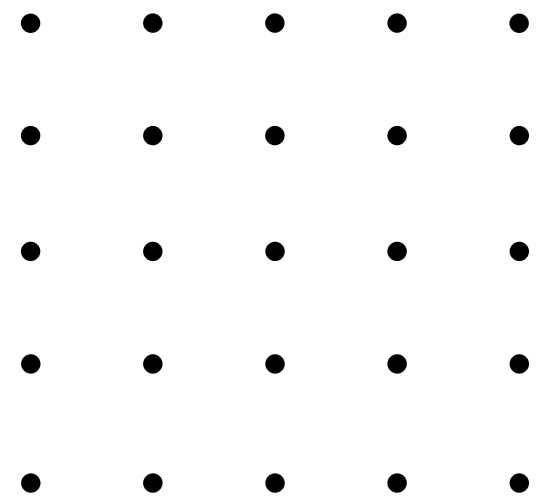

Indonesia on the map

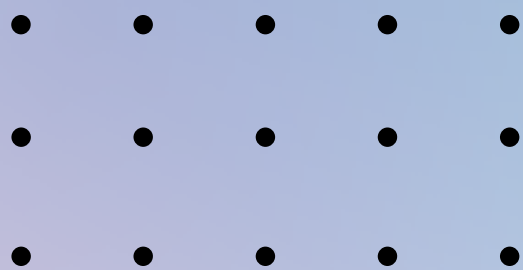
Indonesia is a country in Asia. The capital city of Indonesia is Jakarta; It is located in Java which is in the South - West of Indonesia.

Indonesia's neighbouring countries are East Timor, Malaysia and Papua New Guinea: East Timor is South-East of Indonesia, Malaysia is North-West of Indonesia, and Papua New Guinea is East of Indonesia.

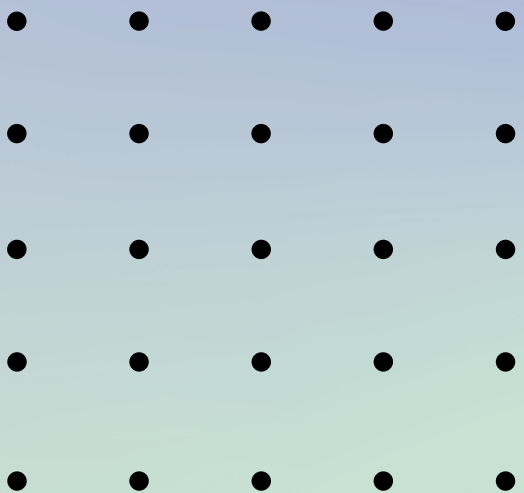


Language

The main language used in Indonesia is Indonesian (What a surprise). Although, they also speak about 700 more languages. Hello in Indonesian is Halo.



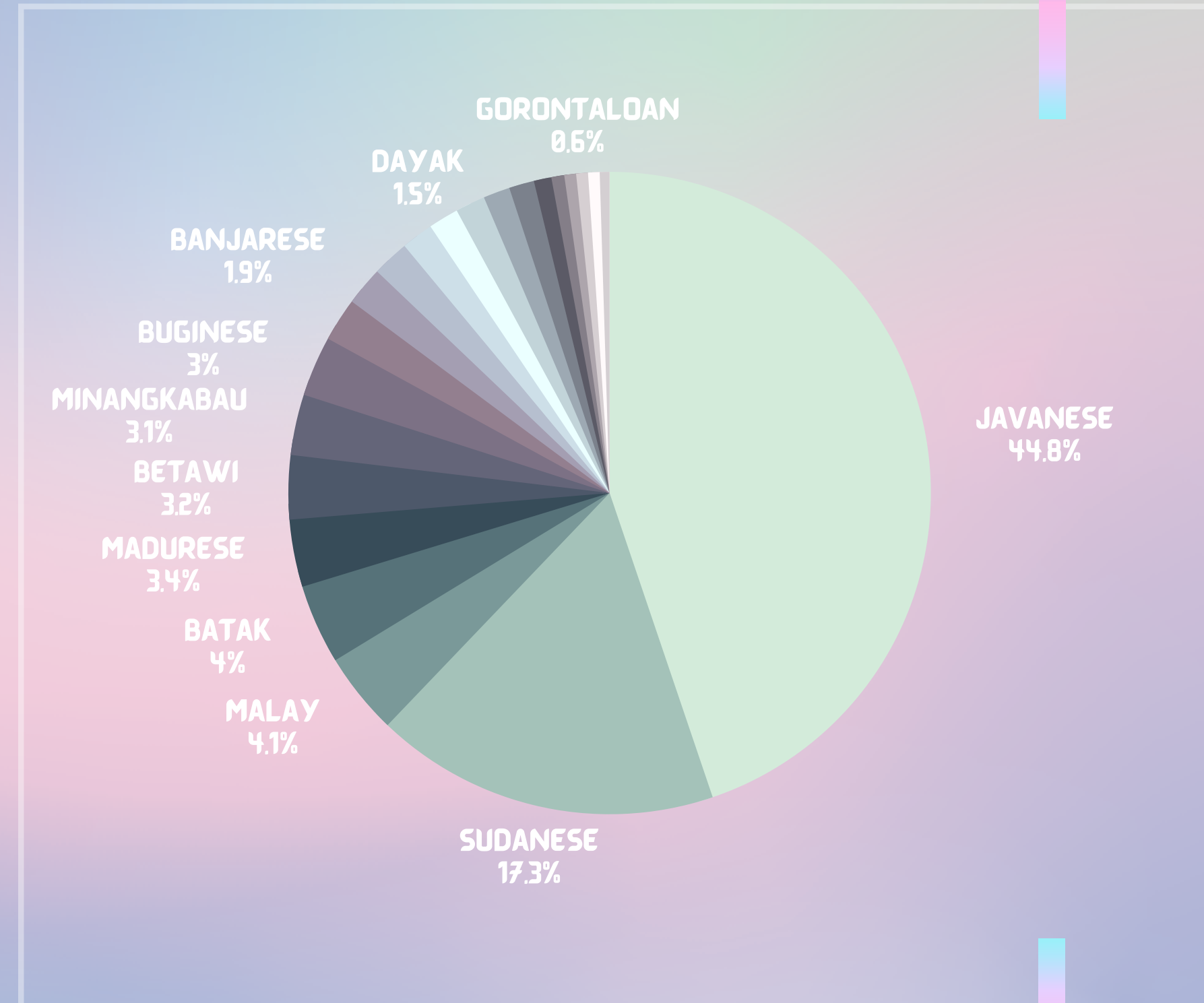

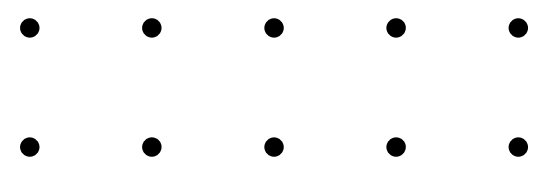


Population

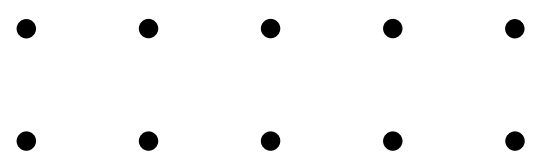
The foreign settlers of Indonesia include: Chinese, Arabs, Indian, Indos, Mardjikers and Japanese people.

Indonesia's currency is called Indonesian rupiah. It has 8 different notes and 5 different coins. The name "Rupiah" originates from the Sanskrit word rupyakam. Many other countries such as India use names same or similar.

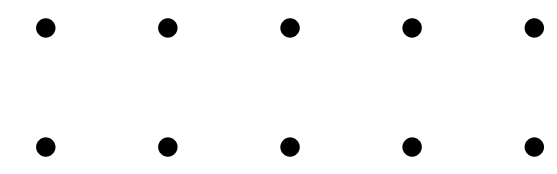

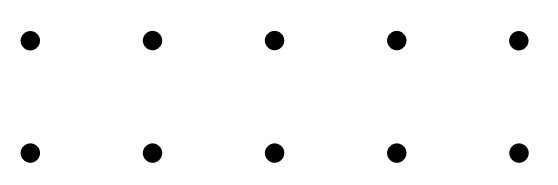
